Eligibility Requirements:

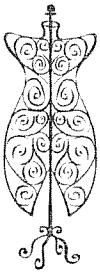
1. Applicants must be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States
2. Applicants must be currently enrolled in fashion/costume design related courses at a high school, college, university or private institution

Scholarship Application Process:

(All applications must be typed on 8 ½ x 11 sheets of paper, using 12 pt. font, with double spacing. Must not exceed 5 pages.)

- A. Page 1 Must include:**
- a. Name (if under 18 years of age, please also provide parent / guardian name)
 - b. Address / City / State / Zip
 - c. Contact phone number and email address
 - d. Fashion school name (i.e. CSULB, Parsons, etc.)
 - e. Fashion school address / city / state / zip
 - f. Fashion school instructor name, contact number and email address
 - g. Fashion classes taken: (i.e. knitwear design, textile design, sketch, costume design, pattern design, sewing, etc.)
 - h. Number of months / years designing fashions
 - i. Applicant signature and date
- B. Page 2 & 3 Must answer the following questions:**
(the responses to these three questions below can be as short as 1 page in length, but must not exceed 2 pages)
- a. Why do you love fashion?
 - b. Who or what inspires your fashion designs and why?
 - c. How will this scholarship help you?
- C. Page 4 Must include:** (does not have to be a full page in length)
- a. Fashion/costume design instructor recommendation letter with signature
- D. Page 5 Must include:**
- a. Color pictures of 2 different outfits designed and constructed solely by applicant

The top 25 designs will be showcased at the Eco-Couture at the Aquarium Fashion Show Fundraiser on October, 8, 2009. The top three (3) designs will be awarded monetary scholarships.

Who May Enter:

Any student currently enrolled in fashion/costume design courses at a high school, college, university, or private institution

Couture Outfit Specifications:

All outfits must be non offensive and cover the body appropriately. The outfit must contain in whole or in part the item(s) purchased at Goodwill.

Judging:

All designs will be judged on the basis of:

1. Recyclable, renewable and reusable factor
2. Total cost of items purchased
3. Creativity and originality
